We are pleased to announce that Fall 2021 rehearsals for the Greece Concert Band (Tuesday nights from 7PM-8:30PM), the Greece Choral Society (Monday nights from 7:15PM-8:30PM) and the Greece Community Orchestra (Monday nights from 7PM-8:30PM) will begin the week after Labor Day at 75 Stutson Street.

At this point, we are planning for 1 ½ hour rehearsals, and masks will be required when entering and exiting the building. Masks and covers will be optional when seated and performing. The Choral Society's in-person rehearsals are for vaccinated singers, and the Sanctuary at 75 Stutson Street will provide ample room for social distancing while singing. Please note that performance masks and covers, additional social distancing and shorter rehearsals may be necessary as COVID-19 guidelines change.
